HOA policy prohibits opening carded gates and doors without a valid amenity card. You are responsible for anyone you admit. Admitting more than 2 guests or admitting guests who fail to comply with posted rules may result in suspension of amenity access. Residents ages 16 and up are permitted to use the gym. Residents 15 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
