The Bonterra Village Pool is open! Each household in good standing is allowed up to two guests per day. Everyone is required to sign in with their name and amenity card number upon entering the pool area. Gym and pool access is restricted to Bonterra residents and their guests. Please bring your amenities card as you can not enter without your card. Security will be present as needed going forward.

Waterfowl deterrents are being placed in the pool area and we will continue to address the issue of these unwanted guests.

Please remember our amenities are for the enjoyment of all residents. Failure to follow the rules and lifeguard's instructions may result in being required to leave and possible amenity suspension. You are responsible for anyone you admit. Admitting more than 2 guests or admitting guests who fail to comply with posted rules may result in suspension of amenity access. Please report lost or missing cards to board@bonterrahoa.com. If your card is used to let others in, you are responsible for any damages.

The number of Bonterra Village homes purchased by investment firms for rental continues to grow. Please contact board@bonterrahoa.com if you are interested in joining the Rental Cap Vote committee. A 67% majority is needed to amend our CC&Rs and the 2021 vote to cap rentals fell short by less than 40 votes.
