

2023 BONTERRA VILLAGE HOA: POOL RULES

(Private Membership Only)

General Rules:

- 1. The lifeguard(s) on duty will enforce the following rules. The failure to obey the lifeguard(s) with repeated offenses will result in the suspension of privileges from the pool area. If the offender(s) is/are of minor age, the owner of the home will be notified of the offense(s) and the cause(s) for the suspension of pool privileges.
- 2. <u>No children under the age of 14</u> are permitted to swim and/or loiter in and around the pool and pool area, under any circumstances, without a parent or other obligated adult present with them at the pool. No solo swimming.
- **3.** For safety reasons, there can be no running, pushing, jumping on others, dunking, or holding others under the water or loitering in the bathroom areas. Due to the depth of the pool, there will be no diving.
- **4. Appropriate and safe** behavior is expected **at all times** on and about the pool area.
- Any food items taken into the pool area or surrounding areas are the responsibility of the homeowner. No glass, bottles, chinaware nor items in breakable containers are allowed in the pool and picnic area. No gum is permitted in the pool area. Each resident using the pool area is responsible for cleaning up any debris on the pool tables, pool chairs and pool deck area. Trashcans are provided for cleanup.
- **6.** Tobacco products (i.e. cigarettes, vapes, etc.) are not permitted in the pool or pool area. Cigarette disposal areas are located outside the fenced-in pool area.
- **7. No alcoholic beverages are allowed** in the pool and around the pool area.
- 8. Water wings, children's small round floats, snorkel tubes, face masks and soft plastic balls under 12" diameter are permitted. No tennis balls are permitted. Small floats are allowed at the lifeguards' discretion. If the pool is crowded or the float is too large, it can block the view of the lifeguard(s).
- 9. No pets, bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, scooters or other vehicles are allowed in the pool area.
- **10.** No one will be permitted to swim with open or infected wounds, bandaged or not.
- **11.** Babies and toddlers in diapers <u>must also wear rubber pants and/or swim diapers</u>. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the proper disposal of those respective diapers.
- **12.** A parent or guardian **must supervise children at all times** in all areas of the pool and pool area.
- 13. Cut-offs and other improper swimwear are not allowed in the pool. Revealing attire will not be allowed. Lifeguards are allowed to ask residents to leave and change, if their pool attire is not acceptable.
- **14. Deck chairs and tables cannot be reserved** for individuals, families and/or gatherings.
- **15.** <u>No weapons allowed</u>. The possession of any and all dangerous weapons is prohibited in and around all Bonterra Village amenities, including the pool and pool area.
- **16. Profanity and abusive language will not be accepted or tolerated**. Continued disregard of this rule will result in the suspension and loss of association pool and amenity privileges.
- **Guests are limited to two (2) per resident unit per visit**. Special exceptions for additional visitors may be granted with advanced approval by contacting Cedar Management. (For example: more than 2 grandchildren visiting or out of town guests visiting for a few days.) Please notify BonterraAmenities@mycmg.com a minimum of 3 business days in advance of the request.
- 18. Any person <u>NOT</u> obeying a lifeguard's instruction to leave the pool at closing will be considered trespassing and the lifeguard(s) will call 911 for assistance.

Features (Children's) Pool:

- 1. A parent or guardian must supervise children in the features/wading pool at all times. The features/wading pool is for children (8) and under. This includes the 10-minute rest period each hour designated for the lifeguards.
- 2. No lifeguards are on duty for the features/wading pool.

Pool Open Dates/Hour: THE POOL WILL BE OPEN FROM MAY 13 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 17, 2023

- 1. The pool is open from 9 am to 8:30 pm daily. Anyone entering outside these hours is trespassing.
- **Lifeguards are on duty from 9:30 am to 8:30 pm daily.** The pool and lifeguard hours are for general references. Please understand that times **may change based on a number of circumstances**, including local school schedules.
